### **Things that are not liked:**

- Cars go over speed limit on High St and Burycroft
- Too dark - more street lighting needed
- Don't want church to be used as village hall as there would be too many issues with scheduling funerals, weddings etc
- Village Hall is not a good idea as there are not enough people in village to maintain it and there are many amenities in close proximity, eg. Sutton Courtenay, Abingdon, Clifton Hampden

### **What needs to change/new ideas**

- A zebra crossing at Waggon & Horses
- The road around the Green is in very bad condition and needs repairing
- Involve the Vicar in CCG
- Car boot sales should be on The Recreation Ground as it's bigger and the Green is deteriorating
- A shop
- A petition to get the empty house on Tollgate Road renovated and rented/sold
- Some of the money raised at car boots and other events should be used to maintain the Green and the roads around it - half the people who have been asked to contribute to road maintenance on Green don't use that part (along from Old Post Office) - the Church will not pay towards it as not long ago C of E wanted to close St Paul's, only the Friends maintain it now and no funds will be forthcoming from Cof E coffers.
- Car boot sales should be on Recreation ground at least some of the time as it is too much wear and tear on the Green
